## **Tips On Being A Disciple**

- 1. Be open to new experiences. Don't be afraid to try something new. Ask if you do not understand how to do something. There are plenty of adults who will help you.
- 2. Be faithful. Say a prayer before you serve, asking God to walk with you and help you. When you are done, say a prayer thanking God for the opportunity to serve. As appropriate, say a prayer with those you are serving.
- 3. Be prepared. Know what you are going to do, where to go and when you are supposed to be there. Bring with you what you are asked to bring or what you have volunteered to bring.
- 4. Be respectful. Use inside voices, shake hands with people you meet, look people in the eye and speak up when visiting, do introductions, remember to say please and thank you.
