From a young age, Jonathan dreamed of becoming a pastor. Though he cannot read, he carries a Bible with him and flips through it as he recites prayers.

According to his job coach, when Jonathan prays, "You can't imagine that he is a person with a disability. If you don't know him, you wouldn't know that he isn't a pastor."

Jonathan graduated from Building a Caring Community's (BCC)Young Adult Program in December of 2017. Since then, he has secured a job as assistant to the pastor in his parish. He accompanies the pastor to meetings, joins him on home visits and says prayers with the sick.

No longer isolated by disability, Jonathan contributes to his community. BCC has given him the skills to be independent and successful, and the confidence to act on his faith.
