MARCH FINANCIAL UPDATE

March closed quarter one with \$93k in receipts and \$82k in expenses. Larger service invoices for heating and cooling systems are being managed. Year-to-date, receipts are nearly \$24k above budget due to early pledge fulfillment. Expenses are over budget by \$158, but overall trending closely as expected.
