STITCHED WITH LOVE: BLESSING 120 QUILTS FOR THOSE IN NEED

Today we will bless 120 quilts handcrafted by First Lutheran's dedicated quilting group. Each month, these volunteer quilters come together to assemble, stitch and complete quilts intended for Lutheran World Relief (LWR). LWR collaborates with partner agencies worldwide to distribute these quilts to individuals displaced by fires, floods, hurricanes, political unrest and war and who are in urgent need of shelter and warmth. Over the years, First Lutheran quilters have created and shipped more than a thousand quilts to communities around the globe, including within the United States. The quilts will cushion our backs as we bless them, pray for those who will receive them and send them off to show God's love for our neighbors. So you will get a little taste of the comfort these quilts bring to people who are experiencing upheaval, homelessness, natural disaster or violent conflict.

EMPOWER YOUR VOICE: JOIN THE JUSTICE IN ACTION UPDATE & LISTENING SESSION

Join us at our Justice in Action (JIA) Update and Listening Session today in the Activity Center. This interactive session will begin at 9:20 AM. JIA organizer, Olivia Butts, will update us on the strides made by the faith coalition in advocating for priority community causes - affordable housing, access to mental healthcare and expanded pre-trial diversion. As a member of JIA, First members will have the opportunity to engage in interactive roundtable discussions to voice their suggestions moving forward.

REFORMATION SUNDAY CELEBRATION: FOOD, FUN AND FELLOWSHIP (AND SOME CHURCH BUSINESS)

Next Sunday, October 27, will be a celebration filled with food, fellowship, and fun, along with some important church business. We will celebrate Reformation Sunday with a single worship service at 10:45 AM (accommodating the Good Life Halfsy earlier in the morning). Part of our celebration will include sharing stories and learning about the founding of the Lutheran church through fun, interactive stations for all ages. The stations will open at 10:00 AM and be available before and after the 10:45 AM service. A Bake Sale of Indulgences will also be part of the festivities, serving as a fundraiser for summer camp scholarships and youth trips! After the worship service, we will enjoy a potluck lunch, and we need main dishes, salads, vegetables, and desserts. Singles should bring one dish, and couples/families should bring two. The Town Hall Forum and special congregational meeting will follow lunch. The two agenda items for the meeting are (1) reducing the number of Congregational Council members from 15 to 12, and (2) addressing housekeeping matters related to the First Lutheran Endowment Board.
