Their services for children and families include refugee resettlement, foster care, economic empowerment, mental healthcare, crisis response and more. Global Refuge received an order from the government that suspended funding of their work and called for their staff to immediately stop serving newly arrived refugees in their care.

Gifts are the only way they can continue their work and assure refugees in their care can access the essential resources promised to them. Dig out your coins, dollar bills or checks (yes, "quiet" offerings are welcome too!) and give them to the kids who are excited, willing and anxious to drop it in the Noisy Offering pot during the offertory.
